

# Cash seizures rise head of elections in five states: CBDT

Delhi: In the run-up to the assembly elections in five states, the Income Tax department has more unexplained cash as compared to what was held in these states earlier, CBDT chairman Nitya Gupta said on Wednesday. Gupta said prior to both state assembly and Lok Sabha elections, the enforcement agencies, including the Income Tax department, increased surveillance and got information about unexplained cash and rely on toll-free numbers created for the purpose. "The states where we are right now in election have seized more cash than what was seen in the corresponding time in the state assemblies or Lok Sabha 2019," Gupta told. He said pre-election monitoring of unexplained cash and surveillance is very intense in the entire country as coordinated by the Election Commission and state election commissions. According to sources, in poll-bound Rajasthan year there has been a three-fold increase in total seizure of illegal cash, liquor, drugs, silver etc. Such seizures, which were Rs 322 crore in 2021 and Rs 347 crore in 2022, have risen to 321 crore till October 2023. Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Mizoram are going to poll in November. In July, the apex authority in indirect tax, the tax Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (ITC), issued a Standard Operating Procedure for tax officers to implement the directions of Election Commission with regard to the seizure of freebies, illicit cash, liquor and drugs to taxpayers, and asked them to share information to other enforcement agencies.

## Attacks CM Over 'Love Jihad' Cases

Bemetara: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Wednesday said the Bemetara district in Chhattisgarh has become a centre of "love jihad" and that no one would dare do such an act if the BJP is voted to power in the state. He accused Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel of insulting Lord Mahadev by "naming" a betting app after him.

Addressing a rally in Saja assembly constituency of Bemetara district on the last day of campaigning for the second phase of elections in the state, Shah alleged that Baghel had turned the Education Department from being an education hub to a "centre of betting".

BJP has fielded Ishwar Sahu, whose son Bhuneshwar Sahu was killed in a communal clash in Biranpur village of the district in April this year.

but would also ensure justice to Bhuneshwar Sahu and teach a lesson to those indulging in the politics of appeasement.

Further slamming the Congress government, Shah said Bemetara turned into a centre of "love jihad" under Bhupesh Baghel.

Sahu, Kurmi and Gond communities were under the target of (love) jihad while the Bhupesh Baghel government remained asleep, he said. "I promise, you bring BJP to power, no one will dare commit such an act," he said.

Targeting Baghel over the alleged Mahadev betting app scam, Shah said, "Bhupesh Kakkas destroyed Raman Singh. During the Raman Singh-led BJP government, Durg division had become a centre of education. Baghel turned it into a centre of satta (betting)."

Shah said Baghel could have named the app after his own name. Wednesday is the last day of campaigning for the second phase of state polls on November 17.

# BAVUMA CONFIDENT OF ENDING SEMI-FINAL Jinx

Tembha Bavuma was aware that Australia are not a "Mickey Mouse" team, but the South African captain on Wednesday sounded confident of his side's ability to defeat the five-time champions and end the Proteas' World Cup semi-finals jinx.

Ahead of the last-four match here on Thursday, history is heavily stacked against the SA who have lost in the semi-finals of the showpiece four times, with two of them coming against the Aussies.

"You know, we're not coming up against a Mickey Mouse team. Australia have a lot of experience and confidence in knockout games, so we've got to respect that," Bavuma said.

Backed by some powerful batting performances, South Africa have been impressive in the league phase, but Bavuma said the semi-final would be a different ball game.

"I'd hate to say that we deserve to go through because of the way we played our cricket. I don't think that's the way things go."

"But I think from our performances, from the processes that we've followed to get to this point, we'll continue to learn on that and we believe that will take care of the result in itself," he said.

However, that self-belief has not given way to overconfidence.

"A lot of people believe that this could be the year that we see ourselves win a final. As a team, individually we'd like nothing better than that. But we also respect the game of cricket," he said.

Bavuma said there is a sense



of calmness in the dressing room unaffected by the adversities of 1992, 1996, 2007 and 2015 when they had endured semi-final heartbreaks.

"I guess they're all important in the semi-finals. I think like you say with the way we've performed as a team it's obviously created a lot of positive sentiment but obviously high expectation," he said.

"There's a sense of calmness within the team and obviously the normal level of anxiety that you would expect of going into the game tomorrow. But I think we'll take a lot

of confidence with our performance up until this point," he said. Personally, Bavuma was excited to play in a World Cup semi-final.

"You want to treat it as just another game. But I guess you're forcing me to acknowledge that occasion. With that opportunity, I know it will mean a lot for the family and people back home."

"It would be nice to have another press conference with you guys on the 18th of November (ahead of final) - but yeah try not to get too much into those emotions," he said.

Not 100 per cent but confident of playing Bavuma had a hamstring issue during their last match against Afghanistan and the skipper said he's still not 100 per cent fit for the semi-final.

"Physically, I feel alright, obviously not 100 per cent. I can't tell you medically, but I think for me from a feeling point of view, that's what I can attest to," he said.

Bavuma, however, said he's confident of making the playing 11.

"I'm quite confident, but I mean, it's not a unilateral decision that will be made. In

a state of mind, obviously a bit nervous about the game," he said.

Talking about his mediocre form in the event, Bavuma said he would take confidence from the good starts he had given with Quinton De Kock, a couple of times.

"Yes, I haven't scored the bulk of the runs within the team. Got it in quite a couple of times, haven't converted."

"So, I guess from that point of view, also knowing that I play a key role with Quinton De Kock in terms of our partnership, we've been involved in a couple of 50 plus partner-

ships, so I take a lot of confidence in that."

"I guess tomorrow my focus will be a lot on that, making sure that if we're batting first, we make sure we take care of that first 10 overs. And then generally after that, it's about me personally as a batter and if I can be ruthless."

Bavuma played down the pressure factor.

"The pressure will always be there. I think even if at this stage, I'm averaging 50 or whatever, I'd still feel pressure. But you have to go out there and deal with it."

Two-spin play Bavuma said he would go for two spinners — Keshav Maharaj and Tabraiz Shamsi — the combination he preferred against India in their last match here.

"We feel that it potentially could be a wicket that assists the spinners a lot more. So, I guess naturally, so, I think will be a focus on our spin."

"If it is up to me, I'm definitely playing our two front line spinners, Keshav (Maharaj) and (Tabraiz) Shamsi. We obviously have Aiden (Markram) as well, who also gives us an option there," he said.

Their batting suffered a meltdown against India and were shot out for 83 with Ravindra Jadeja and Kuldeep Yadav sharing seven wickets between them in a group match here on November 5. But Bavuma said their batters don't have any insecurity complex.

## We've not faced any pitch issue so far: Australia skipper

A raging pitch controversy may have taken the centrestage ahead of the World Cup semi-finals but Australia skipper Pat Cummins on Wednesday said they have "faith" in ICC and his team has not faced any issue so far in the ongoing tournament.

Hours before India's highly anticipated semi-final against New Zealand at the Wankhede in Mumbai, reports emerged that the Indian cricket team management had sought a "slow pitch" for the game.

"Yeah, I saw that (the report)... Obviously ICC curators who manages that, I'm sure they are all over making sure it's fair for both teams," Cummins said ahead of their semi-final against South Africa at Eden Gardens.

"So far this tournament that we've played on, I've not seen any issue."

According to the report, a fresh pitch was originally planned for the first semi-final but now it will be played on an "used" surface to assist the home team's spinners. The report also claimed that if India make the final in Ahmedabad, a slow pitch is expected at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Motera.



As per the ICC's Playing Conditions for the World Cup, the host association is "responsible for the selection and preparation of the pitch" and there is no requirement that a knockout fixture must be played on fresh pitches. Incidentally, the pitch on offer for Thursday's semi-final at the Eden Gardens is also an used surface and hosted the England-Pakistan group phase match.

The only stipulation in their Pitch and Outfield Monitoring Process reads: "It is expected that venues that are allocated the responsibility of hosting a match will present the best possible pitch and outfield conditions for that match."

There has not been any official complaint from the Kiwis as both the teams inspected the pitch on offer at the Wankhede from close quarters on the eve of the match.

## Maxwell available for semi-final: Cummins

Glenn Maxwell, whose thunderous knock against Afghanistan acquired the status of an epic, is on the menu and is available for the World Cup semi-final against South Africa, Australia skipper Pat Cummins said on Wednesday.

Showing incredible will-power, Maxwell had battled severe and multiple cramps in his body to conjure up a magical unbeaten double century to take Australia past the finish line.

Maxwell needed time to recover and had missed Australia's last match against Bangladesh on November 11 in Pune.

"Glenn Maxwell is all clear. He is all good. He was a little bit sore yesterday. We get scans a lot of the time just to make sure that if there is something, we know what we're dealing



with and fortunately it came back all okay. So he's fine," Cummins said ahead of the semi-final.

Chasing 292-run target, Australia were struggling at 91 for seven in 18.3 overs when Maxwell took charge and lit up the Wankhede Stadium with his pyrotechnics on November 7.

Cummins said that Australia will announce their playing XI at the time of toss on Thursday. It remains to be seen whether Cummins goes with Marnus Labuschagne or Marcus Stoinis in the do-or-die match against the Proteas.

"We will announce our XI at

the toss tomorrow," said Cummins when asked if Australia will go into the match with an extra all-rounder or a batter.

The pitch of the Wankhede Stadium has come into focus in the lead-up to the first semi-final between India and New Zealand with foreign media indicating that the hosts could be micro-managing the pitch conditions for their World Cup campaign.

India have managed to get a used pitch for the semi-final instead of a fresh pitch, it has been reported. However there is no rules that says a used pitch can't be picked for a semi-final match.

The ICC has clarified that "changes to planned pitch rotations are common towards the end of an event of this length, and has already happened a couple of times."

## PSL could be moved to UAE or SA due to elections in Pakistan

The Pakistan Super League (PSL) next year could be moved to the UAE or South Africa if the PCB doesn't get the government's clearance to host the event in February-March due to general elections in the country.

The Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) confirmed on Tuesday, after a meeting of the PSL general council here, that it would seek formal advice from the government on finalising the PSL-9 dates because of the general elections slated on February 8.

The PSL is generally held annually between Feb 19-20 and March 20-21.

There has been talk in the PCB that some officials and franchise owners are in favour of the PSL to be held in UAE or



South Africa next year to avoid any interruption in the scheduled dates of matches.

The argument being given is that even the BCCI had organised the IPL in South Africa and UAE in emergency situations, such as the elections in India.

The early editions of the PSL were held in the UAE because no teams were willing to play in Pakistan due to security concerns.

But since 2021, the PSL has been held entirely in Pakistan,

even during the Covid-19 pandemic.

A reliable source said that opinion was divided on whether the PSL should be held in Pakistan or abroad, with some franchisees and board officials keen on having it in the UAE while some others were resisting the move as it would impact the PCB's profits.

The PCB said that the franchisees had also asked the board to complete the process of selling the media and other rights of the PSL as soon as possible.
